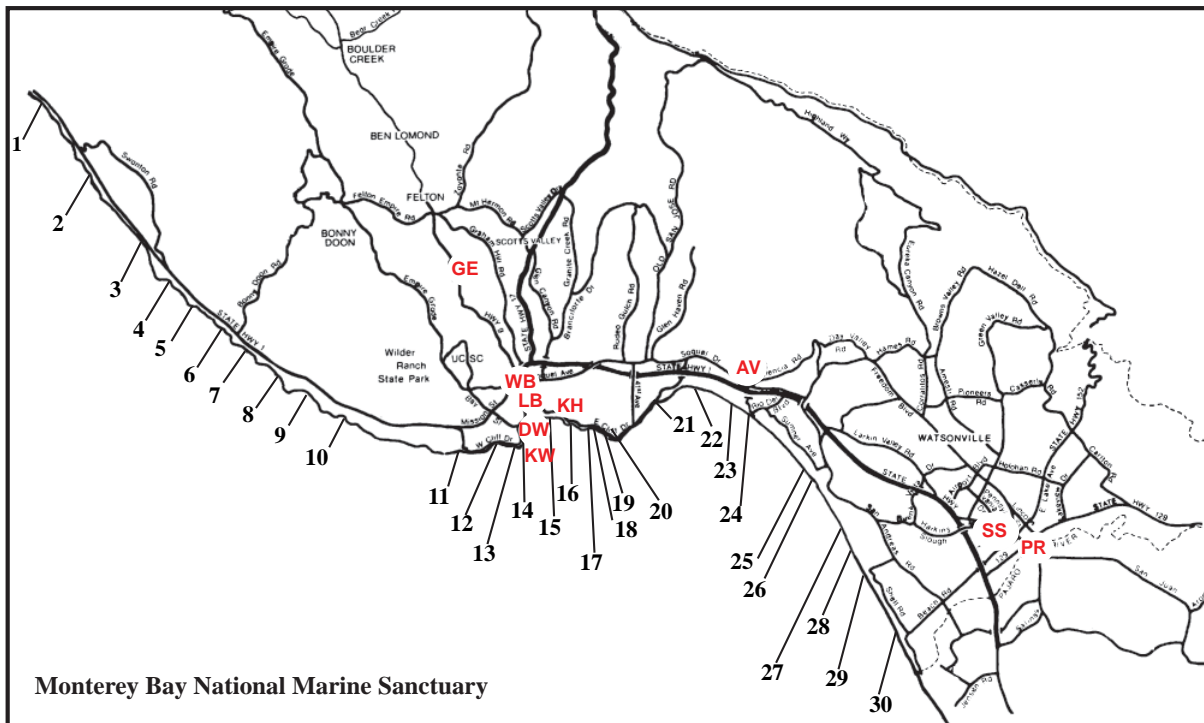


Annual Coastal Cleanup Site Map 2007

Under Served River and Creek Sites are in need of volunteers!

LB - Laurel St. Bridge

Hwy 1 N. (aka Mission St.), left on Laurel St. to Front St. Park in one of the local parking lots. Meet at Mimi de Marta Commons on the east side of the bridge.

WB- Water St. Bridge

Take Water St., past River St., cross over the bridge, take the first right into the County Buildings parking lot. Park and walk back to the bridge.

DW- SCUBA Cleanup of the Santa Cruz Wharf

Take Center St., past the police station and onto the wharf. Park there. Look for registration by the farthest landing. If you need dive equipment you must register ahead of time and arrive by 8:30 am. There will be some equipment available free of charge.

KW- Kayak Cleanup from Santa Cruz Wharf

Take Center St., past the police station and onto the wharf. Park there. Registration will be at Venture Quest Kayak Shop. If you need kayak equipment you must register ahead of time and arrive by 8:30 am, there will be some equipment available free of charge.

KH- Kayak Cleanup from Santa Cruz Harbor

Take Soquel Ave. to Seabright Ave., turn right. Follow until Murray St. and turn left. Follow over the bridge. First right onto Lake Ave. and then first right into the harbor. Registration will be at Kayak Connection's slip at the U dock. If you need kayak equipment you must register ahead of time and arrive by 8:30 am, there will be some equipment available free of charge.

GE- Garden of Eden

From Hwy. 1, take Hwy. 9 North towards Felton 4.7 miles. Park in the Ox Lot Parking on the right side. Go through the southern green gate and stay right on the trail until you hit the railroad tracks. Turn right and walk for about 10 minutes along the tracks until you see the beach access on the left.

AV--Aptos Village Park

Take Hwy. 1 South to State Park Dr. exit. Turn left over highway and then right onto Soquel Ave. You will pass two traffic lights and go under the trestle bridge. Take your first left over the railroad tracks, follow signs to the park. Parking inside the park.

PR-- Parajo River-River Park

Hwy 1 South. Take a left on Riverside Dr. exit. Right on Union St. Left on Front Street. Meet at River Park.

SS--Struve Slough

Hwy 1 South to Watsonville. Take Main st/Hwy 152 Exit. Turn right on Green Valley Rd. and follow across the overpass. Meet at the Pajaro Valley High School.

Beach Cleanup Sites

1—Waddell Creek

16 miles N. on Hwy 1 from Western Dr., across from the entrance to Big Basin State Park.

2—Greyhound Rock

14.5 miles N. on Hwy 1 from Western Dr.; steep paved walk to beach.

3—Scott Creek

11.5 miles N. on Hwy 1 from Western Dr.; parking on shoulder.

4—Davenport Landing

10 miles N. on Hwy 1 from Western Dr.. Road loops back to Hwy 1; use either entrance.

5—Davenport Beach

8.5 miles N. on Hwy 1 from Western Dr.; parking across from Arros Market.

6—Bonny Doon

Approximately 7 miles N. on Hwy 1 from Western Dr. Beach is west of the highway at Bonny Doon Road.

7—Yellowbank/Panther Beach

6.5 miles N. on Hwy 1 from Western Dr., long dirt road on the left.

8—Laguna Beach

6 miles N. on Hwy 1 from Western Dr. Located between N. & S. Laguna Rd. Parking on right; trail across from parking towards

9—Four Mile Beach

3.5-4 miles N. on Hwy 1 from Western Dr. Park on the left, with a 1/2 mile walk past agricultural land and wetlands.

10—Three Mile Beach

2.7 miles N. on Hwy 1 from Western Dr., just past 3056 Coast Rd. Park on the left with a 1/2 mile walk to beach.

11—Natural Bridges

Hwy 1 N. (aka Mission St.), left on Swift St., right on Delaware, left at Swanton Blvd.. Once at the Ocean, turn right into Natural Bridges parking lot.

12—Woodrow Beach

Hwy 1 N. (aka Mission St.), left on Bay St., right on California Ave., left at Erret Circle, left on Woodrow, right on West Cliff. Parking spaces on left. Stairs to beach are 100 ft. to the north.

13—It's Beach / Lighthouse Field

Hwy 1 N. (aka Mission St.), left on Bay St., right on West Cliff Drive to lighthouse parking lot. Beach stairs are 100 feet north of lighthouse.

14—Cowell Beach

Hwy 1 N. (aka Mission St.), left on Bay St. Drive 1.5 miles. Park along Bay St. and walk to West Cliff Dr., go left and down hill; beach is to the right of the wharf.

15—Seabright

Hwy 1 South to Morrissey Blvd. exit, and turn left. Take a right onto Morrissey Blvd., at Water St. turn right. At Seabright Ave. turn left and follow all the way to the end and turn right. Park along the street.

16—Twin Lakes / Harbor

Hwy 1 S. to Soquel Ave. Turn right at light, then immediate left onto Soquel Ave. Turn left at 7th Ave and follow all the way to the beach. Turn left at East Cliff Dr. and park across from beach.

17—Black's Beach

Hwy 1 S. to Soquel Ave.. Turn left at light, right on 17th St.. Turn right at East Cliff Dr., and left at 14th Ave to the beach.

18—Sunny Cove

Hwy 1 S. to Soquel Ave.. Turn left at light, then right at 17th Ave. Go straight, past Portola onto East Cliff Dr., keep to the right onto Sunny Cove Beach.

19—Moran Lake

Hwy 1 S. to 41st Ave. Turn right at light, turn right at Portola, turn left at 26th Ave, turn left at East Cliff and on to the lake. Park in lot next to the lake.

20—Pleasure Point & The Hook

Hwy 1 S. to 41st Ave. Exit. Go right on 41st Ave. right on Portola Dr., then left on 30th Ave, then left on East Cliff. Check in with Pack Your Trash at Elizabeth's Market.

21—Capitola City Beach

Hwy 1 S. to Bay Ave. Turn right at stop sign, turn right at Capitola Ave, and take the road into the village. Park, walk to beach south of wharf.

22—New Brighton State Beach

Hwy 1 S. to the Park Ave exit. Follow signs to New Brighton. Short staircase to beach.

23—Seacliff Beach

Hwy 1 S. to Seacliff/State Park exit. Stay to the right. Beach entrance will be straight ahead.

24—Rio Del Mar Beach (Esplanade)

Hwy 1 S to Rio Del Mar Exit. Go right at the exit and follow Rio Del Mar Blvd. until it drops down into Esplanade.

25--Hidden Beach

Hwy 1 S. to Rio Del Mar Exit. Go right and stay right on Rio Del Mar for 1 mile. Take a left at Cliff Dr., go uphill and drive for .7 miles. Veer to the left onto the not a through street and into the parking lot. Walk down the path, past the playground to the beach.

26—Seascape Beach

Hwy. 1 S to San Andres Rd. exit. Turn right onto San Andres Rd. and follow .5 miles to the blinking light. Take a right onto Seascape Blvd. Go straight through the second stop sign and take a left onto the bridge. Follow signs towards the Seascape Resort Lobby and the registration table will be on the path to the beach.

27—Main Manresa Beach

Hwy 1 S. to San Andreas/Larkin Valley Rd. exit. Go 2.2 miles. After trestle bridge, immediately turn right, into the parking entrance.

28—Uplands Manresa Beach

Hwy 1 S. to San Andreas/Larkin Valley Rd.. exit. Go 2.7 miles. Turn right at Sandollar Rd. Follow signs to beach and take right into parking lot just past the kiosk. Take the long staircase climb to beach.

29—Sunset Beach

Hwy 1 S. to San Andreas/Larkin Valley Rd. exit. Go 5 miles. Turn right at Sunset Beach Rd. Park in the picnic/beach area parking.

30—Palm Beach

Hwy 1 S. to Riverside Dr. exit. Stay to the right. Turn Right at the stop sign. At the stoplight, take a left onto Beach Rd. Follow
